LCBDD BOARD SELECTIONS SAUL BAUER AS NEXT SUPERINTENDENT

At the board meeting last night, the board hired Saul Bauer as the next superintendent of the Logan County Board of Developmental Disabilities. Mr. Bauer has been employed as the Executive Director of West Central Ohio Network since 2001. Mr. Bauer was employed by the LCBDD as a case manager from 1995 until 2001. Mr. Bauer will assume the role as Associate Superintendent for a short transition period and will assume the role of superintendent on January 1, 2012.

When contacted after the board meeting last night Mr. Bauer gave the following statements. "I am very thankful for the board's decision to offer me an opportunity to serve the Logan County community as Superintendent of the Logan County Board of Developmental Disabilities. I am honored to have this opportunity and I look forward to meeting with the many people who have a vested interest in the Logan County Board of DD. This is an exciting day for me, to return to my roots in the DD field, to once again work with the many dedicated employees, parents and family members who serve the individuals of Logan County."

In other matters the board discussed the preliminary budget and also the fact that the board was just advised of a 28% increase in health insurance rates for next year. A final budget will be on the November board agenda. The annual public forum will be held at the November 17th board meeting and as always the public is encouraged to attend at 5:30 pm.
