



## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**AWARDS COMMITTEE** – The Awards Committee will meet in June to discuss potential award recipients for the 2010 Annual Meeting and Recognition Banquet scheduled in August.

**BANQUET COMMITTEE** – The 2010 Annual Meeting and Recognition Banquet is scheduled for August 19<sup>th</sup> at the Indian Lake Community Church.
