DIRECTIONS

South of Logan County:

- Follow U. S. Rt. 68 North and take the St. Rt. 68 by-pass.
- Turn right on Sandusky Ave. (St. Rt. 540) and follow this past the U. S. Rt. 33 exit and Sloan Blvd. The Ohio Hi-Point Career is on the right.

North of Logan County:

- Follow U. S. Rt. 68 South through Bellefontaine, to Sandusky Ave. (St. Rt. 540) and turn left.
- Follow Sandusky Ave. past the U. S. Rt. 33 exit and Sloan Blvd. The Ohio Hi-Point Career Center is on the right.

East of Logan County:

- Follow U.S. Rt. 33 toward Bellefontaine.
- Take the OH-540 exit toward Bellefontaine and go past Sloan Blvd.
- Turn right and the Ohio Hi-Point Career Center will be on the right.

West of Logan County:

- Follow U.S. Rt. 47 toward Bellefontaine.
- Stay straight to go onto E. Sandusky Ave. (St. Rt. 540) and continue to follow E. Sandusky Ave. past the U. S. Rt. 33 exit and Sloan Blvd.
- The Ohio Hi-Point Career Center will be on the right.
