The Logan Soil and Water Conservation District will be holding an election for two supervisor positions September 8th.

Any resident 18 years of age or older, who resides in Logan County can seek election to the Logan Soil and Water Conservation District Board of Supervisors. There are two ways that names can be placed on the ballot.

- Candidates for Logan SWCD Supervisor can be nominated by the Logan SWCD nominating committee. This committee consists of several individuals who look for candidates who are interested in soil and water conservation and the protection of natural resources within Logan County.
- Individuals who are interested in running for Logan SWCD Supervisor positions may stop by the Logan SWCD office, 324 Co. Rd. 11, Bellefontaine and pick up a nomination form. The petition must have ten signatures from Logan County residents and/or landowners. Petitions must be returned to the Logan SWCD office by noon Friday August 5, 2011. Candidates meeting the eligibility requirements and deadline will be listed on the ballot for the election being held at the Annual Meeting.

Soil and Water Conservation Districts, located in all 88 counties, are legal subdivisions of state government that provide natural resource management assistance to county landowners and other units of government. The Districts are governed by a five member of elected county residents. Board members serve staggered three year terms and are not paid for their positions as board members.
